

## ABUSE, NEGLECT AND EXPLOITATION

Care and Life Home Health Services Agency will not tolerate abuse or neglect situations; all employees must complete a Disclosure Statement Child/Adult Abuse Information Act form prior to employment and is included in the pre-employment criminal background check.

If a caregiver observes an incident of abuse or neglect, we require the caregiver to implement any of the following steps:

✓ An immediate oral report must be made by telephone to the Home health agency, administrator or any representative officer to:

Also to proper law enforcement agency or the Department of Social and Health Services and, upon request, must be followed by a written Incident Report. Each report, oral or written, must contain the following information, if known:

# If in the case of a child:

- The name, address and age of the child;
- The name and address of the child's parents, stepparents, guardians, or other persons having custody of the child;
- The nature and extent of the alleged: injury or injuries; neglect; and sexual abuse
- Any evidence of previous injuries, including their nature and extent; and
- Any other information that may be helpful in establishing the cause of the child's injury, injuries, or death and the identity of the alleged perpetrator or perpetrators.

## If in the case of an adult:

- The name and address of the person making the report;
- The name and address of the vulnerable adult and the name of the facility or agency providing care for the vulnerable
- The name and address of the legal guardian or alternate decision maker;
- The nature and extent of the abandonment, abuse, financial exploitation, neglect, or selfneglect; any history of previous abandonment, abuse, financial exploitation, neglect, or self-neglect;
- The identity of the alleged perpetrator; and
- Other information that may be helpful in establishing the extent of abandonment, abuse, financial exploitation, neglect, or the cause of death of the deceased vulnerable adult.
- Unless there is a judicial proceeding or the person consents, the identity of the person making the report under this section will be treated as confidential.

## Where to Report?

- **By Fax:** To make a report via fax, please send a detailed written report with your name and contact telephone to **1800-914-0004**. If there is reason to suspect that sexual or physical assault has occurred, such incidents shall immediately be reported to the appropriate law enforcement agency and to the Department.
